History of MMS can be considered fundamental to give identity to a MMS community with past roots towards the future.


The aim of the HMM Symposium is to establish an international forum for preserving, presenting and discussing historical developments in the field of Machine and Mechanism Science (MMS).


The HMM Symposium covers all aspects of development of MMS from Antiquity until the Present and its historiography as not only on:

- heritage of mechanical engineering




